


REBUILD NEPAL Yarsa, Nepal

In 2015, two major earthquakes struck Nepal that destroyed over 900,000 homes and devastated communities. We started by rebuilding 100 homes and a Young Living Academy primary school in Yarsa (Dolakha district). Over the next couple of years, we'll look to help 16 underserved schools and two women's groups that are still struggling to move forward after the earthquakes.

HOPE FOR JUSTICE U.S., U.K., Norway, Cambodia, Uganda, Ethiopia

Human trafficking is slavery, and Hope for Justice's goal is to eliminate it by preventing exploitation, rescuing victims, restoring lives, and reforming society. We help by fully supporting several Hope for Justice Lighthouse Centers around the world as well as the Shine Career School in Cambodia. Both programs are helping victims regain hope and achieve their dreams.





Each year, the Foundation aids members who've been heavily affected by natural disasters. In 2017, Young Living provided over \$6 million in hurricane relief aid. The organization also provides shoes made from recycled denim and tires to each person they treat to help them stay jigger free.
